


#### The History Buff


## The Curiosity Seeker



#### The Seafarer

Boaters stop at Elizabeth City because of our great location on the Intracoastal Waterway. Elizabeth City was made famous by the Rose Buddies in the 1980s and the legacy continues. We offer many amenities such as free wifi, showers, free 48-hour docking and complimentary bikes.

More than 200 years ago, African American freedom seekers used the Pasquotank River and the Dismal Swamp as routes to escape slavery. The National Park Service designated the Pasquotank River site at Waterfront Park as part of its National Underground Railroad Network to Freedom Program.
