



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN UNITED STATES COAST GUARD AND VISIT ELIZABETH CITY, NORTH CAROLINA

PURPOSE: The purpose of this Agreement is to set forth terms by which USCG-TL will allow Visit E-City to use the name "Coast Guard" for the specific purpose of an annual road race.

Request a motion to ratify the agreement between USCG – Trademark & Licensing and Visit Elizabeth City, authorizing the Executive Director and Chair to sign the agreement.

New Business

Proposed Finance Policy Revisions

SECTION 3. PURCHASING POLICY

- K. Restrictions and guidelines under this Purchasing Policy do not apply to approved Special Project Sub-Budgets with the exception of item "I" which still applies.
- L. Special Project Sub-Budgets will be created to accommodate projects outside the typical scope of the TDA annual budget. When created, the sub-budget must be presented to and approved by the TDA Board. Formal bids are not required for purchases under \$90,000 but are required for purchases over \$90,000 within the sub-budget. It is preferable to obtain a minimum of three written quotes for purchases over \$10,000 and required for purchases over \$90,000, except in the case that minimal qualified providers are available, with all aforementioned information documented. The Executive Director or Chair can approve any contract or quote up to \$25,000 in the approved sub-budget. Contracts or quotes over \$25,000 included in the approved sub-budget shall be approved by any two of the following: Executive Director, Chair, Vice-Chair and Treasurer. Items not included in the approved sub-budget shall be ratified by the TDA Board.
